Luke manages Skiporters and understands how quickly a business can be affected without a reliable braodband internet connection. With Skiportes located in the Southern Alps of the South Island, it is a true test to todays technology. From blistering winds to blinding snow and frozen ice. But still the broadband functions without a hitch.

Relying on a internet connection via a satalite antenna on the staff accomidation building lower down the hill the data was sent then via an old 2.4GHz data link to the main office. This conbination of equipment required his attention from time to time to kick back into life and gave continues preformance issues.

WiFi Guys were able to arange a DSL connnection, supply and install a 35Km wireless data link from Sheffield to Tower 2 on the skifield. This is powered via solar panels and a battery pack. The batteries are charged up via petrol generators during the winter season due to the lack of solar energy at no additional cost as the skifield allready had these installed. This reduced the size and cost of the solar panels to produce the energy required to run the data repeater during these months.

From Tower 2, there is an local AP that connects to the main office. This is allow them to install another radio at the workshop in the future and have instant access to broadband and the local network servers etc.

The wireless equipment installed allows for two WiFi SSiD's, the first is their local admin network for staff to access via their laptops, tablets and smart phones etc. The second SSiD is a free hotspot service to the public. Using the latest technology of that used by Internet Service Providers, Skiporters are able to easyly and cheaply upgrade and expand the network in the extream conditions they are faced with.

Luke, Site Manager says the system worked faultlessly last season with no outages over the 2011 season.
